The Ticket Bearer's acceptance of this Ticket and request to enter a Venue to be a spectator at the Event listed on the front of this Ticket are deemed an acceptance and agreement by the Ticket Bearer of the Ticketing License Agreement. Another copy of the Ticketing License Agreement may be requested by calling 1-800-TICKETS. The following is a brief summary of some of the Terms and Conditions in the Ticketing License Agreement.

This Ticket is a revocable license from SLOC for the Ticket Bearer to be a spectator at an Event. SLOC reserves the unrestricted right to terminate the license granted by this Ticket, without cause and for any reason, including any of the reasons outlined in the Ticketing License Agreement, immediately and without having to make any refund. SLOC's Postponement and Cancellation Policies are in the Ticketing License Agreement. All disputes relating to this Ticket shall be governed by Utah law and shall be litigated, if at all, in and before a court of competent jurisdiction located in Salt Lake County, state of Utah, to the exclusion of the courts of any other county, state or country.

Ticket Bearers assume all risks and dangers incidental to each Event, whether at an outdoor Venue or an indoor Venue and whether occurring prior to, during or after the Event, including, among other things, injuries caused by other spectators. There are inherent risks involved in traveling to and being present at outdoor and indoor Venues, such as changing weather, variations or changes in terrain, distances between transportation drop-off and parking locations and the Venue locations, snow or ice conditions, surface or subsurface conditions such as bare spots, forest growth, rocks, stumps, lift towers and other structures, and their components, collisions with athletes, volunteers, SLOC employees, or other spectators, pucks, hockey sticks, sleds, skis, poles, and other flying objects or flying debris in spectator wear, or injury from high decibel level noises or bright lights. The Ticket Bearer expressly assumes all such risks and dangers, and also assumes all risks of property loss at any Venue.

Utah Code Sections 53-12-801.1 and 76-10-531 state that any person (including a person licensed to carry a concealed firearm) is prohibited from transporting into an Olympic Venue any firearm, ammunition, dangerous weapon, explosive, chemical or incendiary device. Storage is not available at any Venue. An Olympic Venue includes a specific location: (a) that is secured by a perimeter and public access is controlled, and (b) where spectators view Olympic Events, or (c) that is designated for media or official athlete housing not open to the general public. Violation of this prohibition is a class B misdemeanor if the violation is with a firearm, ammunition or dangerous weapon. Violation of this prohibition is a first-degree felony if the violation is with an explosive, chemical or incendiary device, as those terms are defined in Utah Code Section 76-10-405.

The Ticketing License Agreement contains a partial list of prohibited and restricted items and activities within any Venue. Additional lists of prohibited and restricted items and activities may be posted at each Venue. A Ticket Bearer found with prohibited items or found misusing restricted items inside a Venue is subject to having the items confiscated and being removed from the Venue.
